

THE BOOK

Claudia Porta, a **yoga** teacher, has experienced this practice for a long time with her own children and has tried to make it suitable for little ones, turning it into a **game**. The result is a book that presents a position combined with a small **story** on each page. This way, the smaller ones can better understand what they are doing. The **drawings** are by the illustrator Sophie Fatus who, like the author, loves and practices yoga. For those who already know yoga and want to bring their children closer to this **oriental** practice. For those who do not know **where to start** from. For anyone who wants to seek harmony between **body** and **mind**, relax, find inner **balance** and, at the same time, **play** with children. For the little ones it will be, above all, a **fun** activity; but adults **know** that having fun, children will also learn to understand their own body and have greater **confidence** in themselves.

THE AUTHOR

Writer, **blogger** and yoga teacher, **Claudia Porta** was born in Turin in 1975. She studied the Montessori Method integrating it into the education of her own children and worked at the Montessori school "La Loupiote" in Sainte-Maxime (France). Sophie Fatus was born in Paris and lives in Florence. 



Their family and artistic partnership has produced exceptional books and feature films including *La Creazione*, *Il Presepio*, *Il calendario dell'Avvento*, and *Aladdin* (with DVD), all published by Gallucci.

THE READERS

For over **forty years**, Cristina Làstrego and Francesco Testa have been creating stories for children. Giovanna is a long-time character, the protagonist of a **cult** series, published in books, periodicals, films and translated into over 14 languages. 

THE BOOK

THE AUTHORS

Robert Louis Stevenson (Edinburgh, 1850 – Samoa Islands, 1894) was the author of novels and tales that have become classics of universal literature, some of which have already been published by Gallucci, such as *The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*. **Roberto Innocenti** (Florence, 1940) began in the 1960s as a self-taught designer in advertising and animation. He is the only Italian winner of an **Ibby Andersen Award** as best illustrator. **Andrea Rauch** (Siena, 1948), who edited the texts and book, is one of the most important Italian graphic designers.

THE BOOK

Hay must be protected, but it must also be ventilated. That's why hay-barn windows are usually shielded. The Tuscan peasants do this using arched lintels and vertical bricks: repetitive models, but also original in composition and texture. With 12 masterful drawings, and as many short stories, one for each month of the year, Roberto Innocenti and Ermanno Detti lead their own personal reconnaissance in the social and material history of Tuscany. Their focus lies on the remains of the agricultural sharecropper world, in order to remind adults, and pass on to the little ones the memory of a civilization and the wisdom that is gradually disappearing.

THE AUTHOR

Roberto Innocenti (Florence, 1940) is one of the greatest illustrators in the world, the only Italian winner of an **Ibby Andersen award**. Together with Andrea Rauch, he has created for Gallucci the illustrated edition of *Treasure Island*, where the evocative atmosphere of Stevenson's famous novel comes to life through his drawings. Here, he is at work with another old friend, **Ermanno Detti** (Manciano, 1939), author of dozens of children's books and animator of the specialized magazine "Il pepe verde".

THE READERS

Innocenti's **time** is time itself, with its memories and **visions**. Just as for Detti it's **fairy tales** and fantasy. This portrait – containing words and images of the **rural** world in a time before television and industrialization – is dedicated to those who want to keep the memory of places and fundamental values alive, which today are at risk, and are starting to slowly disappear. Adults, therefore, but also young readers who will recognize, through the attitudes of **animal** characters, vices and virtues of yesterday's, but above all, today's men. 

He has won two **Andersen awards**, and has published with Gallucci *Le filastrocche della Melevisione*, *Rime del fare e non fare*, *Rime di fiaba e realtà*, *Nidi di note*, *CantaFilaStrocche*, *Ufficio Poetico Tuttestorie*.

Gianni De Conno lives and works in Milan, where he teaches editorial **illustration** at the School of Comics. After his artistic studies, he specialized in **set design** and cinema **animation**. Since 1997 he has published, in Italy and abroad, numerous books for children and adults for which he has received **prestigious awards**. Among these, the **Gold Medal of the Society of Illustrators** in **New York**, both in 2009 and 2010.

THE READERS

Bruno Tognolini is a **master of storytelling**, capable of reaching straight into the hearts of children and adults alike. 

THE BOOK

Three precious nursery rhymes, written with a depth and lightness that remind us of the lesson taught by the great **Rodari**. *Il sentiero* (*The Path*) talks about a path

that all the children follow, **by bicycle**, abandoning the **city** of the adults, leaving it **empty** in every sense of the word. In *Le parole strampalate* (*The Weird Words*), **words** themselves, tired of being mistreated and neglected, decide to teach the adults a lesson. *Ventimila leghe* (*in fondo al mare*) (*Twenty Thousand Leagues - Under the Sea*), finally, speaks about the selfishness of those who always want to be apart from someone else, to separate: if the seas did the same, we would no longer have exchanges of **water** or fish, but only an immense desert.

THE AUTHORS

Gianmaria Testa (Cuneo, 1958 - Alba, 2016) was a famous Italian singer-songwriter and guitarist.

Valerio Berruti (Alba, 1977), an artist, lives and works in Piedmont. Central themes in his illustrations are young boys and girls. He has exhibited his works in major galleries, from the **Centre Pompidou** in Paris, to the **Venice Biennale**.

Marco Lorenzetti (Senigallia, 1970) has already illustrated for Gallucci *Il topo e la montagna*, written by Antonio Gramsci. His **talent** has also impressed Alessandro Baricco, who chose him to illustrate the *Promessi sposi* (*The Betrothed*) edited by Umberto Eco for Scuola Holden and "l'Espresso".
